Cowboy Olympics

\$400 per group, up to 50 guests
(additional cost for larger groups)

Our Entertainment Director will divide your group into teams. Each team will be given a different color band to differentiate between teams.

EVENTS THAT CAN BE INCLUDED
IN YOUR "COWBOY OLYMPICS":

EGG & SPOON RACE Participants are on a horse with an egg in a spoon. They have to cross the finish line without dropping egg.

DON'T SPILL THE WATER Outside event only. 2 person teams; one on foot and one on horseback. The object is to cross the finish line with most water in the container.

RUN OUT OF TOWN ON A RAIL 7 to 10 people race up and down the arena on a 10' PVC pipe rail, trying not to fall.

TEXAS "BASEBALL" TOSS Outside event only during dry season. Pitch & Hit "Cowboy Baseballs" for distance.

TEXAS SKIING Four people on one set of "Texas Skis", competing with other teams.

TUG OF WAR Done with ropes.

SHEEP DRESSING Race to put a bandana, T-shirt and shorts on a live sheep.

WRANGLER RELAY Run a relay doing these everyday wrangler chores while dressed as a cowboy: hauling buckets of water, riding a stick horse, hauling hay, fetching eggs as fast as you can.

DONKEY PULL 1 person rides and 1 person pulls the donkey. If you're lucky the donkeys will actually stop at the finish line!
